I am not in favor of an area variance for two rows of parking on two sides for the York Travel Center. This corner property may become very busy with pedestrians, especially children from the nearby public school and from cars and trucks entering and exiting from both Route 36 and Route 63. Two areas with rows of double parking will create a safety hazard for people and cars, especially with drivers entering and exiting in multiple directions. With the addition of tractor trailers using these same driveways there is increased potential for accidents that may include school children. This proposed variance would increase congestion at what is already a busy intersection in town. Please consider the safety of York's children, other pedestrians, as well as drivers, as you make your decision on this variance.
