

TOWN OF YORK

Local Law No. 2, 1970

A local law to retain elected assessors for the Town of York.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of York, Livingston County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. The offices of assessor in the Town of York shall continue to be elective, as provided by the law in effect immediately prior to the effective date of section 1556 of the Real Property Law of the State of New York, which was on August 1, 1970.

Section 2. This local law shall be submitted to the electors of the Town at a special election not less than sixty (60) days after the adoption of this local law, the date of such special election being fixed by the Town Board as January 7, 1971, from 2:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., prevailing time.

Section 3. This local law shall become effective pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law only if approved at such special election by the affirmative vote of a majority of the qualified electors of the Town voting upon the proposition.
